Tasha's recipe of the month...



Freshly baked pizza

What you will need:

- Wholemeal pizza base/ pitta breads
- Tomato puree
- Carrots, mushrooms and onions
- Cheese plus any toppings

First boil your vegetables and blend them mixing them in with the tomato puree. (hidden veg and they won't even notice!) You can then let your child help to spread this puree over the pizza base. Then simply sprinkle your cheese on and add any topping such as pepperoni or sweetcorn for extras. Bake for between 5-10 minutes!
